PUBLIC HEARING**

In compliance with the Code of Virginia of 1950, and amendments thereto, the Smyth County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing to consider and Amendment to the Smyth County Code of Ordinances Chapter 23, Article III to include provisions related to the segregation of certain personal property classifications for taxation purposes. The Board of Supervisors shall hear comments from citizens concerning the proposed amendment of the Smyth County Code of Ordinances.
